

PRIVACY POLICY

This policy (together with our Terms and Conditions) sets out how we use any information we collect from you, or that you provide to us. WHAT WE COLLECT

We may collect the following information:

SECURITY

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

HOW WE USE COOKIES

A cookie is a small file which communicates with and may be downloaded on to your computer or device when you access a website. Cookies help analyse web traffic or let you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual.
